Highways/Rail

- Reduction in brightness of the lights on Betchworth Station confirmed due to be fixed on 18/19 May. The works completed on Betchworth Station have not had the desired effect to reduce the brightness of the lights, which is impacting residents and is in breach of our dark skies policy. Continued to chase the resolution of this issue with SCRP. Progress has been made, the tops of the lights have now been sprayed. Awaiting confirmation of the impact, resident has stated that there has been an improvement and that the replacement lights will be reinstalled in August which should correct the issue.
- Raised 7 jobs for Pebblehill to Highways maintenance for the following:
 - Culvert by A25 to be cleared of vegetation and silt (logged on 7th June, chased on 20/6 and 29/6, awaiting response have now copied in Cllr Clack)
 - Clearance of compacted mud along the concrete wall from station to A25 (standard roadsweep took place, Clerk has challenged this and stated that it requires more work to clear the drain – awaiting feedback)
 - Clearance of vegetation, trees and cutting back of hedges from A25 to The Station (notification received that this has been done. Clerk to attend site and make inspection)
 - o Refurbishment of bend chevrons (by Pilgrims Way) (this was acknowledged but has passed the 15 days so Clerk has chased)

- o Clearance of vegetation obscuring road signs on Pebblehill (this has been acknowledged)
- Missing white lines from centre of the road from The Coombe to A25 (this has been acknowledged)
- o Requested 2 x waste litter bins (by station and by The Coombe) (this has been acknowledged)
- Raised 2 jobs for The Street to Highways maintenance for the following:
 - Full refurbishment of ALL road markings on The Street (acknowledged, but has passed the 15 days for response. Clerk has chased)
 - Estimate for VAS sign to be installed on The Street before the school (powered and solar)
 (acknowledged, but has passed the 15 days for response. Clerk has chased)

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- Raised job to get vegetation cleared by signs on Betchworth Bridge This has been resolved.
- Raised job asking for an investigation to be completed on the slippy road surface by Betchworth
 Bridge. Response received back, they conducted a moving brake test and were able to stop safely
 without any obvious loss of friction with the surface, this will continue to be monitored. Will respond
 back to challenge, currently awaiting some data from Cllr Potter and Estate Manager. Email issued to
 SCC Highways stating that we are not accepting of response copied to Senior Highways Engineer
- Chased Highways regarding the 2 approved speed reductions for Old Reigate Road and Wellhouse Lane for progress. Acknowledgement received that these are drafted and will be implemented by Christmas
