

Highways Report To Parish Council 3rd July 2023

Wonham Lane Speed monitoring

Highways have put into programme . Date of survey not known . Have confirmed no cost to PC.

Wellhouse Lane Speed Reduction Implementation

Highways now advise that Traffic Regulation Orders are being processed & implementation of 30mph restriction likely to be in place by December.

Betchworth Bridge & Road Surface

Highways Inspector reported that on hard braking test no fault found but test carried out in dry weather conditions so problem & danger not indicative of residents/councillors experience. Clearly the road surface is inadequate in view of the numerous occasions the wall has been damaged with risk to pedestrians. Response has been drafted and sent to SCC copied to Senior Engineer.

Gateways -A25 & Pebblehill

This installation has been cancelled on several occasions due to delayed delivery of fixing posts or not finding a date acceptable to Street Closure Team. Senior Engineer to be pressed to bring forward date for installation as this delay is disappointing.

Pebblehill

We have put Pebblehill Residents' representative fully in the picture on the matters which were rated by PC as first stage priorities for meeting with Senior Engineer which took place. Maintenance items are being implemented & will be monitored such as path clearance to restore to acceptable width.

Traffic calming is residents main concern & in order to move their concerns forward CC Cllr Helyn Clack has agreed to take initiative in meeting/ liaising with residents including consideration of previous traffic calming proposals which were deferred due to water mains replacement & road damage arising.

The Street – Footpath

The low kerb level often breached by vehicles is a constant danger . SCC Engineer was asked for a guidance price for raising kerb & footpath from The Firs to the junction with Old Road. The provisional indication of cost is in the region of £ 70,000.

Councillors to consider whether PC can make a contribution from CIL Fund.
